What is CAP?

The Community Assistance Program (CAP) offers individuals and families facing financial hardship material support such as clothing and household items, free of charge.

Am I Eligible?

To be eligible, you must either be an Okanagan resident or Newcomer to Canada with a fixed address and income below LICO (see reverse).

Who and What Does CAP Serve?

| | Clothing | Linens | Kitchen Items |

Please note: we do not carry items for children or babies.

How do I Access CAP?

To access CAP, you need to contact S.H.A.R.E. Society to schedule an intake appointment. At the appointment you will be assessed for eligibility. Once registered you can shop or be provided material support the same day.

What Documents do I Need?

Documents for Okanagan Residents:

- 1) **Government Issued Photo ID** – for each member accessing CAP (driver's license, passport, BC services card, and more),
- 2) **Proof of Income** – for each working adult (paystubs, notice of assessment, copy of pension cheque or stub, letter from Service Canada, and more),
- 3) **Proof of residency** – for each adult at the same address (tenancy agreement, ICBC vehicle insurance, utility bill, bank statement, home/cell phone bill, and more).

Documents for Newcomers:

- 1) **Passport** – for each member accessing CAP
- 2) **Status Documentation** – for each member accessing CAP (record of landing, confirmation of permanent residence, work permit, study permit, or other immigration documents).

|-------------|-------------------------|
| 1 persons | 19,042 |
| 2 persons | 23,177 |
| 3 persons | 28,859 |
| 4 persons | 36,005 |
| 5 persons | 41,000 |
| 6 persons | 45,470 |
| 7+ persons | 49,939 |
